

## HANDS UP! PACKING GUIDE

The team at ANTaR are glad to loan these hands out to you for a good cause. We have painstakingly sorted and packed them for ease of convenience both on your end, and ours. We seek your understanding and appreciate the help in keeping the hands and posts packed as per these instructions.

*Thank you for sticking to the guide and for allowing us to use our time more effectively to advocate for justice, rights and respect for Australia's First Peoples.*

### HOW IT'S DONE

- Hands are bundled using rubber bands into lots of 25 ● Posts are bagged into bundles of 50
- **Keep the rubber bands and bags for return packing** ● Posts are inserted into hands in the slot with the bend at the top
- **Please DO NOT attach stickers to the hands, or write on them with any permanent or non-permanent markers/pen/pencils.**

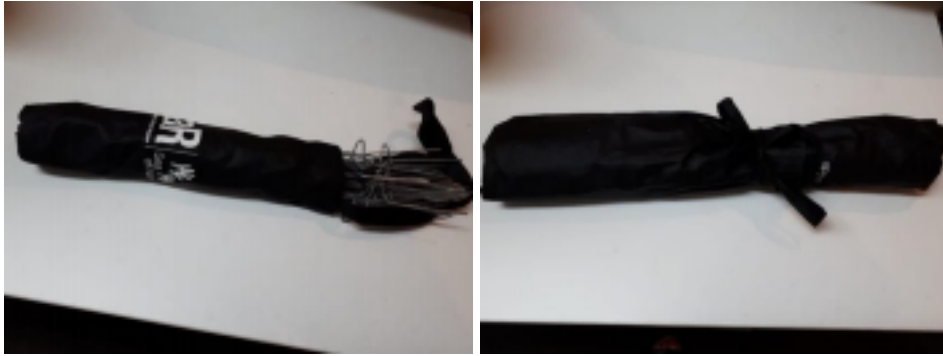


### AFTER YOUR EVENT

1. Clean off dirt and moisture from posts/hands, remove hands from posts.
2. Bundle hands into lots of 25 of the same colour - thumbs all facing the same direction, place band around the thumb and across the palm, one band per bundle.
3. Bundle the posts into lots of 50, using two lots of 25 with bends at opposite ends.



4. Wrap the posts into bags, using one bag for each end of the bundle, tied securely but not knotted.



5. Lay the posts flat at the bottom of the box.

6. Place the bundles of hands on top ensuring each stack is turned the other way with thumbs facing each other to ensure 200 hands will fit per box.
